(1) Received pursuant to a 5% stock dividend paid on February 4, 2011.

Owned jointly by the reporting person and her son and daughter. Does not include 72,323 shares of Class A Common Stock and 151,284 shares of Class C Common Stock owned indirectly by the reporting person in the 401(k) Retirement Savings Plan, the Employee Stock Ownership Plan (ESOP), and the Deferred Compensation Plan.
