- (4) and the option for the remaining 8,093 shares will vest in equal installments on February 1, 2020 and February 1, 2021. The performance criteria was certified by the Committee on February 6, 2019. This grant was approved by the Committee and is exempt from Section 16(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 under Rule 16b-3(d).
