The Timken Company (the Company) has implemented a change to its management structure and now operates under two major business groups, the Bearings and Power Transmission Group, which includes three segments: Mobile Industries; Process Industries; and Aerospace & Defense, and the Steel Group. Beginning with the first quarter of 2008, the Company will report its financial results utilizing these four segments.

Attached is the 2007 (quarterly and annual) and 2006 (annual) financial information, by segment, as if the Company had reported its financial results for the respective period utilizing the four segments. The Company believes that this material may be informative to investors.
